Some Thoughts

- → Important distinction: problem space vs solution space (Jackson, ICSE95 keynote)
- → Hypothesis: the further away the design is from the problem space, the harder it is to discern intent

&Get our basic concepts from the problem space

- > Objects
- > Processes
- > Eta
- → Possible exception: we do some things in the design
 - that are endemic to the solution space (eg, some of the non-functional properties)
 - which intent may be independent of the problem space
