## Huawei Ascend P7 Disqualified by FutureMark for Cheating 3DMark Benchmark Tests International Business Times

- What Happened: The P7 was caught changing its configuration to show higher performance (up to 28%) on popular benchmarks
- How:
  - Code in the device turns on all cores when certain benchmark software is detected (checks the app name)
  - Also runs at higher frequencies for longer
- The Fallout:
  - Their scores were removed from the site
  - However, not much uproar from the industry



## It's Not Just Huawei

- Chart from Anandtech 2013 (2)
- Other methods:
  - Raise thermal limits
  - Overclock GPU
- Other instances:
  - Intel atom in 2013 (3)
  - AMD/NVIDIA/ATI each caught cheating and/or accusing the other at various points (2003-2011)
